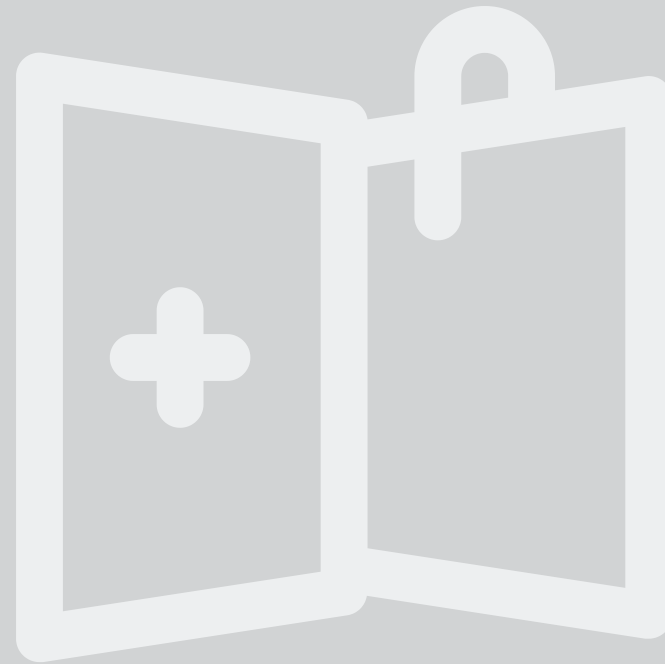


EMERGENCY MEDICINE APP TRAINING PROGRAM
